PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:

- Emptied the trash at Lock 57.
- Mowed Borough parks and properties.

- Cut and removed trees from Wildwood, Pleasantview, Eastwood, Fairlane, Ashwood, and Willowbrook.

- Hauled tires to County Conservation's tire collection event.
- Shoveled mud from the boat dock and ramp, repaired and installed boat docks and made new locating cables.
- Repaired water leak at ballfield concession stand, turned water on and cleaned for rental, replaced two electrical outlets.
- Removed plows and salt spreaders from trucks.
- Checked trucks for inspection, repaired wiring and replaced lights.
- Put flags up at the parks.

- Installed new right-side door on Massey Ferguson tractor.
